
Dear Commissioner Carr:

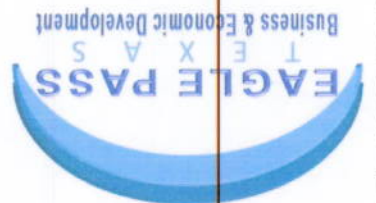
