ENFORCEMENT BUREAU'S STATUS REPORT

1. The Chief, Enforcement Bureau (Bureau), by her attorneys, hereby submits this Status Report, as directed by the Presiding Judge in *Order*, FCC 18M-03 (ALJ, rel. May 31, 2018). Therein, the Presiding Judge directed the parties to address in their status reports the following subjects: (1) the completeness of production of documents and answers to interrogatories; (2) the estimated date when discovery is expected to be completed; (3) outstanding issues; (4) readiness for hearing; and (5) proposed hearing dates at the Commission in Washington, D.C.

Discovery

2. Regarding subjects (1) and (2) above, the Bureau does not have any outstanding requests for discovery from Mr. Crowell and does not anticipate seeking additional discovery from Mr. Crowell unless a new issue is raised or unless the Bureau is made aware of Mr. Crowell engaging in further acts that violate the Commission rules at issue. Accordingly, at this time, the Bureau contends that discovery is complete.

Outstanding Issues

3. Before the case was stayed in 2017, the Presiding Judge ordered both parties to assemble and submit, in chronological order, to the Presiding Judge all emails and correspondence between Mr. Crowell and the Bureau dated January 2000 to the present.¹ In furtherance of this *Order*, the Bureau shall submit for *in camera* review by the Presiding Judge all such emails and correspondence that it was able to locate for the relevant time period on Thursday, June 7, 2018.

Readiness for Hearing and Proposed Dates

4. The Bureau proposes that the hearing, which is to be held at Commission headquarters in Washington, D.C., commence on October 16, 2018. We do not anticipate the hearing lasting more than three days. The Bureau proposed this date to Mr. Crowell, but rather than attempt to coordinate with the Bureau, Mr. Crowell responded that he will not attend the hearing in Washington, D.C.


