
**REPLY COMMENTS OF COMPANY/GROUP XXXXX

Mark A. Smith Off-Road, Inc. dba Jeep Jamboree USA submits these reply comments in support of the Petition for Reconsideration filed by Michael Williams on behalf of Cobra Electronics on 6/28/2017. The subject Petition for Reconsideration recommended the addition of 40 FM channels to the existing 40 AM channels defined in Subpart D – CB Radio Service (CBRS).

We at Mark A. Smith Off-Road, Inc. dba Jeep Jamboree USA believe that there are material improvements to be gained by allowing FM channels in CBRS, especially in terms of quality of service and clarity of communications. We are convinced that these improvements will directly benefit the users of CB radios, not only the professional driver, but also the recreational user. At the same time, we strongly agree that backward compatibility is a must to avoid the CB radios already in the field being rendered obsolete.

With this said, we endorse the addition of 40 FM channels to the existing 40 AM channels, and we encourage the FCC to make the appropriate changes to Part 95 Personal Radio Service Rules, Subpart D – CB Radio Service.
