On June 10, 2019, Colleen King and the undersigned of Charter Communications, Inc. ("Charter") contacted the following individuals regarding the above-referenced proceedings: Aaron Goldberger, Advisor to Chairman Pai; Erin McGrath, Advisor to Commissioner O'Rielly; Will Adams, Advisor to Commissioner Carr; Umair Javed, Advisor to Commissioner Rosenworcel; William Davenport, Advisor to Commissioner Starks; Donald Stockdale and Paul Powell of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; Julius Knapp of the Office of Engineering and Technology; and Giulia McHenry of the Office of Economics and Analytics.

In our discussions, we expressed Charter's support for AT&T's recent proposal urging the FCC to expeditiously issue a Public Notice seeking comment on several outstanding technical issues.<sup>1</sup> In particular, we expressed Charter's concern about the user equipment out-of-band emission limits proposed by the C-Band Alliance, which could impair 5G operations in the band. Charter looks forward to working with the FCC and all stakeholders to resolve these important technical issues.
