Dear Ms. Dortch:

I am writing pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(1) of the Commission's Rules to notify the Commission that on June 7, 2019, Paul Sinderbrand and I met with Aaron Goldberger, Wireless Legal Advisor to Chairman Ajit Pai, and Bret Baker, and intern with Chairman Pai, on behalf of the Wireless Communications Association International ("WCA"). During the course of the meeting, we focused on several issues: (1) the request by the Schools, Health & Libraries Broadband Coalition ("SHLB") and others asking the Commission to further delay the adoption of rules that will permit the licensing of the Educational Broadband Service ("EBS") white space; (2) the deficiencies of the study SHLB filed purporting to establish economic benefits of preserving the EBS eligibility rule; (3) the proposal by the Wireless Internet Service Providers Association ("WISPA") to limit bidders in an auction for the EBS white space to no more than 63 megahertz of spectrum in a given area; (4) rationalization of the existing EBS geographic service areas; and (5) deferring the start date of any new EBS discontinuance rule.
