On January 10, 2019, Christer Fahlgren, Software Architect for Voice & Video, and I met with representatives from the Consumer and Governmental Affairs and Wireline Competition Bureaus to demonstrate Twilio's voice services and how many of our customers' use cases could be harmed under the new opt-out call blocking rule.
