On June 12, 2019, on behalf of Bonneville International Corporation (“BIC”), Mike Dowdle and Jason Englund of BIC, and Ken Satten and the undersigned of Wilkinson Barker Knauer LLP, met separately with Al Shuldiner, Chief, Audio Division, Media Bureau; Chairman Pai and Alexander Sanjenis, Acting Media Advisor; and Evan Swarztrauber, Policy Advisor, Office of Commissioner Carr. On June 13, 2019, the same individuals met with Commissioner O’Rielly, Joel Miller, Chief of Staff and Media Legal Advisor, and Chris McGillen, intern. During the meetings, BIC expressed support for the Commission’s elimination of the newspaper/broadcast cross-ownership restriction in the 2014 quadrennial review of media ownership regulations and its examination of the local radio rule in the 2018 quadrennial review of media ownership regulations, noting its filing of reply comments in the docket.
