Dear FCC,

I recently moved to a new neighborhood in Oakland, CA. Comcast claimed to serve that block, but they've never built an access point (despite having cables in the ground), and when they assessed my building, they said it could be months or years before access became available.

My building has only 4 units, well below the threshold where it becomes economically viable for a large company to install something like fiber.

If it were not for Sonic unbundled copper access, I would not be able to access the internet, in the Bay Area of California, tech hub of the western world.
