I get 2 GB per second fiber optic service from Sonic for \$63.64 including all fees. This level of service is critical for my home and business because I live in an old house with heavy steel mesh in the walls that cut off much of the feed from my centrally located router.

Offers I get from AT&T are for \$70 per month for 200 MB fiber optic service not including fees. Are you kidding me? One tenth the service for higher cost! Its too bad that AT&T has spent the past 10 years acquiring other companies instead of spending money to develop and disseminate state-of-the-art fiber optic service in our communities.

Please deny the petition by major corporations to destroy internet service competition so that I can keep my 2 GB service, which I really do need.
