On June 4, 2019, Amina Fazlullah Policy Counsel of Common Sense Kids Action (Common Sense) and Angela Campbell of the Institute for Public Representation of Georgetown Law (IPR) met with Joel Miller of the office of Commissioner O’Rielly.

In our meeting, Common Sense and reiterated our concern that the proposed changes would reduce the amount of programming available for kids, could decrease the amount of core programming on the air, limit the reach of educational programming and that many families are unable to access substitutes to broadcast programming.
