I am a residential customer who uses broadband internet services to do volunteer work (both environmental and human services) that requires access to and the creation of large files, including photographic files. A little over a year ago I switched off of AT & T to a more competitive, smaller source of internet service that is both less expensive and much more responsive to technical questions and problems. My new provider also provides me with a less expensive telephone service. My situation is illustrative of what can happen when smaller companies can compete with giants like AT & T and Verizon--better, less expensive service. Please do not change the basis of competition for these services.
