I was so happy when I could finally ditch Comcast and AT&T that I had for my Internet and telephone landline respectively, and switch to a gigabit fiber connection provided locally by Sonic.

As I was reminding my neighbors recently, I get better quality, better performance, better service and better support, all for less than half the price.

And I especially enjoy having consistently Internet speed at ~935Mbps download and upload, more than 10 times faster than my previous Xfinity connection, and free phone calls to landlines in Europe where AT&T was charging an arm and a leg.

Please do not dismantle key components of the 1996 Telecommunications Act as proposed by the USTelecom petition. They keep the smaller, local broadband providers alive and able to help not only power families, libraries and schools, but also support local small businesses as well with affordable and reliable internet.

Support the actual American people, not big lobbying wannabe monopolies!
Reject the USTelecom petition!
