Dear FCC,

I am a customer of Sonic in San Francisco and I want you to know that their ability to compete with the big players has directly led to better service for me. I had Comcast, but because they don't have much competition they were always very difficult to work with and slow to roll out high-bandwidth fiber to the home. Sonic was the first to get fiber to my neighborhood, so I switched, and since then I've had no problems with my network (more reliable than Comcast ever was), and better service when I have issues. I am lucky to be in SF where I have this choice, nowhere else that I have lived has had this opportunity, but the solution is not to double down on that it's to further encourage competition. Please keep residential telecom competitive by continuing to provide shared access to the necessary infrastructure, and do not believe USTelecom's claim that no one would be materially affected my fellow San Franciscans would, and all future chance of competition with us.
