Dear FCC,

I want more competition for my internet service. There have been a few times living in Indiana, living in New York, and now living in California where I've been limited to just one internet service provider.

This has meant I've had to be exorbitant fees (including being forced to pay for bundled services I don't want, e.g. cable TV). This has meant having slow connection speeds, or major outages, with no recourse.

I now live in Northern California, and Sonic recently came and installed fiber internet. I was able to break ties with Comcast where I was paying \$200/mo for slow, buggy internet. I now pay \$70/mo for much faster internet with no downtime. This wouldn't have been a possibility if it weren't for competition.
