I am a Professor at the Georgetown University Law Center, Faculty Director of the Center on Privacy and Technology, and a noted expert in information privacy law. On Tuesday, June 14, 2016, I testified to the House Committee on Energy and Commerce, Subcommittee on Communications and Technology about the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the above-captioned proceeding, at a hearing entitled “FCC Overreach: Examining the Proposed Privacy Rules.”<sup>1</sup> In advance of the hearing, I submitted a written statement, attached here for the Commission’s consideration.
