I had DSL from ATT and it was like I was a 2nd class citizen, and the only other option was Comcast, which was just as bad then I went to Sonic's DSL and was able to get an internet connection that was stable. Then Sonic ran fiber when att would only give me 20 megs max and Comcast at 250.

I went with Sonic's Fiber because they priced it very competitive to what is available. ATT has not bothered to upgrade to fiber and Comcast prices are pretty expensive.

Sonic is a game changer, if there were not here I am pretty sure even being in San Francisco, my neighborhood would be underserved (Max speed for the longest time on DSL was 6 megs even when Comcast was at 150 meg) and Comcast pricing is through the roof.

I am a remote worker and internet is a basic necessity to my livelihood.
