BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH OF ROBERT TAYLOR

My name is Robert B. Taylor. I have resided at 500 N. Delaware Blvd. in Jupiter, Florida, since June 1987. I am the licensee of WTRU (FM), Jupiter, Florida.

My career began as an announcer at WIDR, a student operated non-commercial station at the college I attended, Western Michigan University, in Kalamazoo, Michigan. After receiving my Bachelor of Arts degree, I volunteered and served two years on active duty in the U.S. Army, including one year stationed with the 101st Airborne Division in Phan Thiet, South Vietnam, during the war. After my discharge I worked as an announcer and later operations manager at WAOP (AM) in Otsego, Michigan. I also worked as a newsman and announcer at different times at WLKM in Three Rivers, Michigan, WJPW in Rockford, Michigan, and WJEF (AM)-WJFM (FM) in Grand Rapids, Michigan. In June 1971 I put WTPS, Portage, Michigan, back on the air and operated WTPS (later WBUK) until August 1976. I was the licensee of WBUK which I purchased out of bankruptcy while the station was off the air. At WBUK I worked as an announcer, newswriter, operations manager, salesman, bookkeeper and general manager. I owned and operated WRKT AM-FM, Cocoa Beach, Florida, from August 1977 to October 1981. I purchased WXKE (FM) in Fort Wayne, Indiana, in December 1982 and am still the licensee and business manager of this station. I acquired WVSI AM-FM, Jupiter, Florida, in September 1984 when I purchased stock in R & R Broadcasting Corporation, a Florida corporation which was a holding company for the two radio station licensee corporations.



Statement on Integration of Ownership into Management

The ownership structure of the licensee of WTRU (FM), Robert B. Taylor, is a sole proprietorship.

Mr. Taylor has been a legal resident of the state of Florida since 1977. Since June 1987, Mr. Taylor's permanent legal residence is in Jupiter, Florida and he is a registered voter in the town of Jupiter. He resides in a two bedroom apartment on the second floor of the radio station building.

Mr. Taylor also maintains an office in the radio station building. Mr. Taylor resides in Jupiter and proposes to work at the station full time each year from approximately October to May. During the summer months of July through September, Mr. Taylor moves his residence to his summer cottage in Michigan. Mr. Taylor makes at least three or four trips each summer back to his Jupiter office and stays for at least one week each trip.

Mr. Taylor uses the title Business Manager at WTRU (FM). His duties include:

(a) Handling the filing of documents with the FCC including the EEO Reports, Ownership Reports, renewal applications.

(b) Overseeing and arranging for equipment repair and maintenance and consultation with outside engineering consultant.

(c) Preparation of operating ledgers, handling of accounts payable, auditing, preparation and filing of Federal income tax returns for the sole proprietorship.

(d) Interaction and consultation with station sales, programming and engineering personnel.

(e) Community relations within the city of license such as working with Jupiter Chamber of Commerce, Jupiter Hospital and city officials.

During the six to eight months when he will be in Florida on a full-time basis, Mr. Taylor will work a minimum of approximately 25 hours per week at the Jupiter station on station business.


During the summer months when he is in Michigan, Mr. Taylor does paperwork and makes phone calls on station business. During these months, Mr. Taylor works on average approximately 8 hours per week on station matters.





List Of Organizations For Whom Public Service Announcements
Were Aired From July 1985 through March 1987

It has been the policy of WTRU and WEXI (AM) (the stations were simulcast) to respond to community needs with a significant number of regularly broadcast public service announcements (PSAs) which were broadcast almost every hour.

The following pages in Attachment A are a month by month listing of all PSAs aired on the stations from July 1985 through March 1987. They were a total of 3,675 PSAs (not including the Community Calendar and "Happenings" PSA programs in Exhibit No. 8) broadcast in the period which appear on the logs with the organization names for a monthly average of 175 PSA's over the 21 month period, including the issue-responsive PSA's in Exhibit No. 8. Other PSA's were broadcast, but because they are identified only as "PSA" on the logs, they are not included in the totals. Each organization for which a PSA was aired during a month is listed with the total number of PSAs for that organization in that month shown in parentheses.

The PSAs break down to approximately 75% local-regional PSAs and approximately 25% national or state PSAs. All PSAs were broadcast between 6:00 am and 12:00 midnight daily.
