On June 18, 2019, AJ Burton and the undersigned of Frontier Communications Corporation ("Frontier") met with Eric Burger, Spencer Reeves, Meg Schumm, Kelsey Fayer, Becky Chambers, Connor (CJ) Ferraro, Annick Banoun, E. Alex Espinoza, Lisa Hone (by phone), Mathew Collins (by phone), Pamela Arluk (by phone), and Jerusha Burnett, to discuss matters Frontier felt could be addressed at the Commission's upcoming SHAKEN/STIR Robocall Summit.

Frontier detailed its commitment to deploying SHAKEN/STIR on its network and its progress with the same. Frontier also discussed that given some of the challenges around SHAKEN/STIR authentication for TDM calls, Frontier believes that carrier call-blocking for calls that are not authenticated could result in good calls being blocked. Frontier further believes that discussion around these challenges and whether SHAKEN/STIR should be used as a decisive metric for call-blocking would be useful at the July 11 Summit.
