CTIA appreciates and applauds the continued work the Commission is undertaking to evaluate licensing rules for the spectrum bands under consideration in the above-captioned proceedings. In that vein, CTIA is providing for the Commission's consideration the video linked below, which highlights the success of exclusive-use, flexible licensing policies. The certainty that can be afforded through clear, straightforward licensing rules will promote investment in the millimeter wave bands, which is all the more important given the nascence of the 5G technologies that will be deployed in this spectrum. CTIA therefore urges the Commission to refrain from adopting experimental licensing regimes and instead focus on adopting proven, workable rules to foster wireless deployment.
