Per FCC Rule 1.1206, this letter provides notice that on June 19, 2019, Paul Milgrom (via phone), Chairman, and Gary Epstein, Senior Advisor, Auctionomics Inc., and Jennifer Hindin of Wiley Rein LLP, counsel to the C-Band Alliance (“CBA”), met with William Davenport, Chief of Staff and Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Starks.

At the meeting, Professor Milgrom and Mr. Epstein discussed details of the “FUEL” (Flexible Use and Efficient Licensing) auction design that the CBA proposes to use with the Market-Based Approach. Professor Milgrom explained that the FUEL process will be quick, efficient, simple, and fair for all participants. FUEL is a combinatorial auction, and represents the next evolution in auction design, which will provide bidders with unprecedented flexibility by allowing them to easily bid on specific packages for different combinations of licenses. FUEL is also designed to accommodate bidders large and small, national and rural. A copy of the CBA’s June 10, 2019 *ex parte*, which attaches additional details about FUEL, was also distributed at the meeting.¹

The CBA and Auctionomics look forward to continued dialogue with industry stakeholders and the Commission regarding its proposal.
