Thank you for sending.

Questions:

- An appeal was submitted showing that the BEAR review for this FRN was completed before its deadline which would mean the FRN was properly disbursed. Each bill that was submitted shows a previous payment on them. What is the status of this appeal?
- Why is USAC going to deny 2017 FRNs when an appeal for this 2015 FRN has not yet seemingly been processed by USAC ? Shouldn't USAC review that appeal before for this FRN before invoking the red light rule? The backwards processing is going to put up further red tape, delays, and appeals for this reimbursement and FY 2016 and 2017 filings when the 2015 FRN should never have been remitted for re-payment to USAC in the first place.

Your message indicated that the letter you sent to e2e exchange was returned to USAC. We are receiving this notice one day before the dismissal date. None of this is acceptable. We need a better solution that delays this red light letter dismissal until the appeal has been accepted by USAC. The documentation clearly shows all information was submitted to the BEAR reviewer before any deadlines and this path should never have been taken by USAC.
