**REQUEST TO WITHDRAW JOINT APPLICATION
FOR DOMESTIC TRANSFER OF CONTROL**

On April 5, 2016, Axia NetMedia Corporation (“Axia Canada” or “Transferor”), Axia NGNetworks USA, Inc. (“Axia U.S.” or “Licensee”), and Digital Connection (Canada) Corp. (“DCC” or “Transferee”) (collectively “Applicants”), through their undersigned counsel, applied for authority from the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or “Commission”), pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.04 of the Commission’s rules, to enable the parties to consummate a transaction whereby DCC would acquire control of Axia U.S., a non-dominant carrier holding blanket domestic Section 214 authority from the Commission to provide interstate telecommunications services.


Since April 5, 2016, Applicants have substantially changed their business plans. At this time Axia Canada and Axia U.S. do not intend to consummate a transaction whereby DCC acquires control of Axia U.S. Rather, Axia Canada and Axia U.S. intend to enter into a transaction that would allow for the transfer of control of Axia U.S. to Axia NGNetworks Trust, a U.S. owned trust.

Should DCC desire to acquire Axia U.S. in the future, after the transfer of Axia U.S. to Axia NGNetworks Trust, a separate and new application for authority will be sought from the Commission.

Once this Request for Withdrawal has been filed with the FCC, the Applicants will notify Team Telecom of the withdrawal of their Joint Application for Domestic Transfer of Control.

Based on the foregoing, Applicants respectfully request that the Commission grant their Request to Withdraw their Joint Application for Domestic Transfer of Control without prejudice.
