
Re: *Terrestrial Use of the 2473-2495 MHz Band for Low Power Mobile

Dear Ms. Dortch:

I am writing pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(1) of the Commission's Rules to notify the Commission that on June 22, 2016, I, on behalf of the Wireless Communications Association International ("WCA") had a telephone conversation with Edward "Smitty" Smith, Legal Advisor to Chairman Tom Wheeler, to discuss WCA's positions in the above-referenced proceeding. During the course of the discussion, I reiterated the concerns raised in WCA's June 13, 2016 *ex parte* letter regarding the Commission's failure to provide the public with the requisite notice and opportunity to comment regarding opportunistic use of the Globalstar spectrum by unlicensed users and the practical questions that remain as to how any automated system would protect Broadband Radio Service and Educational Broadband Service licensees. In addition we discussed WCA's concerns regarding any relaxed out-of-band emissions mask at 2495 MHz.
