JOINT DEPOSITION SCHEDULE

1. Pursuant to *Order*, FCC 16M-19 (ALJ, rel. June 8, 2016) and *Order*, FCC 16M-20 (ALJ, rel. June 21, 2016), the Presiding Judge directed Patrick Sullivan and Lake Broadcasting, Inc. (collectively, Lake Broadcasting) and the Enforcement Bureau (Bureau) (collectively, the Parties) to submit a deposition schedule on or before June 24, 2016 identifying each witness to be deposed by the Parties, as well as the date, time and location of each deposition. Lake Broadcasting, Inc. and the Bureau hereby submit the requested joint deposition schedule.¹

¹ In *Order*, FCC 16M-20, the Presiding Judge directed the Parties to conclude all depositions, “including deposing, transcription, and review for error” by September 16, 2016. *See Order*, FCC 16M-20, at 1. The Bureau notes that its normal turn-around time for a standard full-day deposition is 10 days at a cost of approximately \$2650.00 per deposition. Given that the depositions are scheduled for September 14 and 15, the normal turn-around time will not be sufficient to meet the September 16 deadline. The cost for next-day turn-around is approximately \$4,000.00 per deposition. The Bureau is working to obtain the necessary approvals for the increased deposition costs to meet the Presiding Judge’s directive.


