

My name is Ronald Wilcox and I represent hard-working Americans who will be harmed if the industry petitions regarding the TCPA are granted.

In one case, I represented a disabled woman who received 4,200 phone calls in 8 months! That is 17.5 phone calls a day, every day, for 8 months. In another case, I represented a man who was out of work, disabled, and received 360 calls after asking that the calls stop.

As was commented on the Senate Floor:

Computerized calls are the scourge of modern civilization. They wake us up in the morning; they interrupt our dinner at night; they force the sick and elderly out of bed; they hound us until we want to rip the telephone right out of the wall.
