SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION FOR CONSENT TO TRANSFER OF CONTROL

Medicine Park Telephone Company, Inc. (“Medicine Park”), by its counsel, hereby supplements its request¹ for authority to transfer control of Medicine Park from Hilliary Family First, LLC’s Previous Control Group to its Post-Transfer Control Group.

Pursuant to the request of Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) staff, and in accordance with the requirements of Section 63.04(a) of the Commission’s rules, Applicants hereby submit additional information regarding certain individuals that directly or indirectly own at least ten (10) percent of the equity of the applicant, and the percentage of equity owned by each of those individuals. As stated in the initial application, Medicine Park is a privately-held corporation 100 percent owned and controlled by Hilliary Family First, LLC. Hilliary Family First, LLC is 50 percent owned by the Edward A Hilliary, Jr. Revocable Trust and 50 percent owned by the Alice Jo Hilliary Revocable Trust dated April 16, 2014. Each of the individuals listed below holds a 14.29 percent interest in and is a beneficiary of both the Edward A Hilliary, Jr. Revocable Trust and the Alice Jo Hilliary Revocable Trust dated April 16, 2014.

Given that each of the trusts holds a 50 percent interest in Medicine Park, each of the individuals holds a 14.29 percent indirect interest in Medicine Park.

- Southern Plains Cable, LLC ("Southern Plains") is a CLEC.
- Texhoma Fiber, LLC ("Texhoma") is an Internet service provider ("ISP").
