Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b), notice is hereby provided of an oral *ex parte* presentation in the above-referenced docket. On June 17, 2019, Kathleen Ham, Senior Vice President, Government Affairs of T-Mobile US, Inc. ("T-Mobile"), Vonya McCann, Senior Vice President-Government Affairs of Sprint Corporation ("Sprint," and collectively with T-Mobile, "Applicants"), and other representatives of the Applicants¹ met with FCC General Counsel Thomas Johnson, Deputy General Counsel Ashley Boizelle, and Joel Rabinovitz of the Office of General Counsel. During the meeting, the representatives of the Applicants discussed several issues raised in the Applicants' previous submissions and relevant to the Commission's competition analysis, including the network improvements and efficiencies achievable through the merger and projected in the Applicants' network and economic modeling as well as the variety of participants in the wireless market. The representatives also discussed the relevant market definition, general framework for the competition analysis, and the FCC's relevant authority under the Communications Act.
