Dixon Acquisition LLC
Line 1030 – Broadband Comparability

In a December 2014 Order (FCC 14-90), paragraphs 119-123, the FCC created Section 54.313(a)(12) which requires recipients of High Cost Program and/or Connect America Fund support that are subject to broadband performance obligations to submit a broadband reasonable comparability rate certification.

The Company believes its 3 Mbps/.5 Mbps service is being offered at rates that are reasonably comparable to rates in the closest urban area and, hereby, certifies that it is in compliance with 47 C.F.R. § 54.313(a)(12).

Currently, Dixon's maximum speed available is 3 Mbps/.5 Mbps service, for which there is no rate stated on the FCC's Public Notice. However, as stated by the FCC Wireline Competition Bureau in the Public Notice released on April 16, 2015 (DA 15-470): "To facilitate benchmark calculations, the Bureau will post an Excel file and online tool in which providers can plug the relevant variables to determine the benchmark for specific service characteristics at <http://www.fcc.gov/encyclopedia/urban-rate-survey-data>."

The Company has reviewed the comparable rates in the nearest urban area, which is Mediacom Iowa, LLC's rate for 3 Mbps/.5 Mbps of \$44.95 on the spreadsheet, therefore, the Company believes its current residential broadband rate of \$32.99 for 3 Mbps/.5 Mbps service meets the reasonable comparability requirement and certifies that it is in compliance.

Please note that it is the Company's intention that future upgrades to 10 Mbps/1 Mbps will be priced to also be in compliance with the reasonable comparability rates.

Lifeline Telephone Assistance Program

A Lifeline [application form](#) is available from your local telephone service provider, the Iowa Utilities Board, or most [Community Action Agencies](#) in the state. To apply, simply complete the application form and then return it to your chosen participating provider. Additionally, residents of Tribal lands who are eligible for Lifeline, should check with their local telecommunications provider to inquire about additional benefits, including potential Link-Up telephone-installation benefits.

Re-certification forms are sent to all Lifeline subscribers each year. In order to continue receiving Lifeline assistance, these forms must be completed and returned to the subscriber's local telecommunications provider within 30 days. If the re-certification form is not returned, the telecommunications provider will discontinue the subscriber's Lifeline assistance.
