One of the most crucial and successful parts of my operating plan would be totally wiped out if I were restricted in my person-to-person solicitations into residential homes.


The economy and day-to-day living makes it hard enough to survive as an independent contractor. We do not need a legislation passed that would impede with our abilities to make a living.


Dear Mr. Secretary:






