DECLARATION OF LANCE B. FERRANTI

Lance B. Ferranti, under penalty of perjury, deposes and states the following.

1. My name is Lance B. Ferranti. I reside at 719 S. Westgate Avenue, Los Angeles, CA 90049. I am making this declaration for submission to the Federal Communications Commission.

2. I hold an amateur extra class license. In the summer of 1991, I obtained an application to become a volunteer examiner from the W5YI-VEC. Prior to August, I received a card from the W5YI-VEC which identified me as a VE; however, it was not until August 7, 1992 that I received a packet containing rules and regulations, tests, etc. A copy of the envelope, with postage meter date of August 5, 1992 and showing \$3.54 in postage is attached as Attachment I.

3. On June 20, 1992, I spoke with Mr. David Morse, WW7K, concerning possibly participating in the Official Observer Program as an assistant working with Fred Ordway, KI6QK. I followed up with him with a few calls in July 1991 with no positive response. During the course of my discussions with Mr. Morse, he remarked to me that Fred Ordway and Charles Pascal had operated a repeater station and radio school. My telephone record for the June 20, 1991 telephone call is attached as Attachment II. Mr. Morse's number is (818) 893-2817.


4. I was a volunteer examiner at the August 4, 1991 test session. Mr. Terry Pierce was the Contact VE for the examination session and he was in charge of the testing session, including both the written and Morse Code exams. The exam session on August 4, 1991 was conducted with the utmost propriety to my knowledge. I have no reason to believe the exam was compromised in any way from what I saw that day.

Lance B. Ferranti, under the penalty of perjury, deposes and states the following.

5. On approximately the second week of July 1991, I spoke with Mr. George Sfair, KJ6TQ briefly about joining the Southern California Amateur Repeater Association (446.225 megahertz) Repeater. He told me to respond to the repeater owner, Mr. Fred Ordway KI6QK through the club Post Office box in South Pasadena, CA or by telephone in Los Angeles. I spoke with Mr. Ordway approximately a few days later and expressed a desire to be a member of his 440 repeater group. We discussed similar interests in general including flying, radio equipment, and Volunteer examining. At no time in our conversation did propriety of radio schools or examiners come up. At one point he remarked to me in words to the effect that there had been a separation between his radio group and Charles Pascal's 220 megahertz station repeater group. He responded in a positive manner to my request for membership however, he couldn't establish the phone patch privileges immediately due to technical considerations. Lastly, I asked Mr. Ordway if he exercised his examination privileges which he responded that he used to test for the Gordon West School from time to time. I concluded the conversation by giving Mr. Ordway my telephone number and amateur call sign. He never called me to consummate my request for repeater station membership.
