Demonstration of Ability to Function in Emergency Situations

Waitsfield-Fayston Telephone Co., Inc. (“Company”) and its broadband affiliate, Green Mountain Access hereby certifies that it is able to function in emergency situations as set forth in the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 47, Part 54, Subpart C, §54.202(a)(2)¹. The Company’s network is designed to remain functional in emergency situations without an external power source, is able to reroute traffic around damaged facilities, and is capable of managing traffic spikes resulting from emergency situations.

To meet its requirements that it maintain functionality without external power, the Company has multiple generators for its central office switching offices and remotes and keeps adequate fuel to insure continuous operations in the event of a long term power outage. It also has eight-hour batteries that provide further back up capability in its network. The Company’s has deployed redundant / diverse routing for critical network resources and has the ability to redirect of traffic in the event of facility damage. This ability to change its call routing also allows the Company to manage traffic spikes throughout its network, as emergency situations require.

The Company employs a full time construction crew and fiber splicers that are readily available to repair any cable or fiber damage. Additionally, the Company maintains a written disaster recovery plan to meet service emergencies resulting from failures of power service, sudden and prolonged increase in traffic, fire, storm, or acts of God, and has trained employees on emergency procedures.

Waitsfield-Fayston Telephone Co., Inc. provides throughout its service area broadband service at actual speeds of at least 4 Mbps downstream/1 Mbps upstream to all but approximately 2.0 percent of customers, with latency suitable for real-time applications, including Voice over Internet Protocol. It's service is provided without usage capacity limits and is reasonably comparable to offerings in urban areas as determined in an annual survey. Locations that are limited to below 4/1 service are reviewed on a regular basis, worked into annual construction budgets and built to when overall construction costs are deemed to be reasonable.
