Dear Ms. Dortch,

Per FCC Rule 1.1206, this letter provides notice that on June 28, 2019, Peter Pitsch, Executive Vice President, Advocacy & Government Relations, C-Band Alliance (“CBA”); Susan Crandall, Associate General Counsel, Intelsat US LLC; Michele Farquhar and Arpan Sura of Hogan Lovells US LLP; and Jennifer Hindin, Henry Gola, and Sara Baxenberg of Wiley Rein LLC, counsel to the CBA (collectively, the “CBA Participants”), met with the FCC personnel listed in Attachment A.

To begin the meeting, the CBA Participants gave an overview of the CBA’s market-based proposal and reiterated the CBA’s commitment to clearing 200 MHz (inclusive of a 20 MHz guard band) of C-band spectrum within 18-36 months of a final FCC order. The CBA Participants also described the proposed market-based auction, which is designed to rapidly repurpose spectrum for terrestrial 5G operations in a transparent and efficient manner that provides spectrum-acquisition opportunities to all interested participants. In addition, the CBA Participants discussed statutory provisions and requirements relating to post-auction fiscal implications. Finally, the CBA Participants noted that the CBA remains steadfast in its commitment to protect existing customers and the highly reliable C-band programming distribution ecosystem that today serves nearly 120 million U.S. households.
