On behalf of the Pribilof (Alaska) School District, this summary memorializes meetings via teleconferences between the undersigned and Commission staff. On June 29, 2018, I met with Amy Bender, legal counsel for Commissioner O'Rielly, and on July 5, 2018, I met with Travis Litman, legal counsel for Commissioner Rosenworcel. Both meetings were regarding the Application for Review filed on May 30, 2017, by the Pribilof school district.¹ In the meetings, Pribilof emphasized that granting the application for review was in the public interest. Issues the first year of the new E-rate IT system had caused the errors in the application filing process. Further, Pribilof had not received actual notice of the denial of its funding request
