On July 5, 2017, David Aldworth, Gary Fry and Robert H. Jackson, representing Teliix, Inc. ("Teliix"), met with Pam Arluk, Edward Krachmer, Greg Capobienzo and, via telephone, Irina Asokov, with respect to Teliix's previously presented positions in the above-numbered proceedings. We explained how elimination of originating access charges, including the 8YY database query ("DBQ") charge, would deprive small CLECs and, indirectly, small I-VoIP providers, with service revenue that, in turn, can be used to bolster their technology and network investments and promote innovation and competition. Teliix also discussed the "Toll Free ExchangeSM." The attached documents were provided to the Commission attendees.
