On July 3, 2019, Rachel Petty and Dieter Renken of RingCentral, Inc. ("RingCentral") and the undersigned, of Harris, Wiltshire & Grannis LLP, met by phone with David Furth, Deputy Chief, Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau (PSHSB), Erika Olsen, Senior Legal Counsel, PSHSB, Kenneth Carlberg, Chief Technologist, PSHSB and John Evanoff, Deputy Chief, Policy and Licensing Division, PSHSB.

During that meeting RingCentral reiterated its interest in providing users the most advanced, flexible and robust emergency calling solutions possible. RingCentral urged the Commission to ensure that any new regulatory requirements not outstrip available technology and explained RingCentral's related concern that providers be given enough time to undertake the development necessary to implement solutions that meet new regulatory mandates.
