To whom this may concern,

There must be more communication on the front end as it relates to this important process and set alarms where deemed necessary. In Moultrie, Georgia one of our most recent examples is that a wireless company sent an electrical contractor not an engineer or even someone who could speak to the wireless company's plan. Our Utilities Director and more informed the person that we have a local review process, but they didn't want the review and the electrical contractor was focused on where he was instructed to put the poll/tower. Our local people would have to possibly provide power, fiber and more while protecting the other utilities in the immediate area, however the process did not proceed and we never received an answer or response on the wireless company's immediate plan. Also, we have specifications on where we want towers in regard to the right of way ie we keep them to the edge of right of way while the prior referenced person had been instructed to put it outside of what we recommend for Moultrie's right of way.

All in all, we can make this a "win, win," process for the respective wireless company and our residents if they respect our local review process and understand they we as elected officials and city employees have a duty to protect the best interests of our residents and the aesthetics of our community and more.
