Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 31, 2018, in accord with the Federal Communications Commission's requirements that eligible telecommunications carriers (ETCs) annually re-certify the eligibility of their Lifeline subscribers and report the results to the Universal Service Administrative Company, to relevant states and Tribal governments, and to this Commission,<sup>1</sup> CenturyLink submitted its 2017 Lifeline re-certification results (by Study Area Code) for thirty-five states, including Florida and Georgia.<sup>2</sup>
