**OPPOSITION TO SECOND SUPPLEMENT TO PETITION TO DISMISS OR DENY**

CBS Corporation and CBS Radio Inc. hereby oppose the Second Supplement to Petition to Dismiss or Deny filed by Edward R. Stolz II d/b/a Royce International Broadcasting Company, Golden State Broadcasting, LLC, Silver State Broadcasting, LLC, and Major Market Radio, LLC (the "Second Supplement"). Stolz alleges that comments made by Scott Pelley during the June 16, 2017 broadcast of the *CBS Evening News* contained "fake news."

Stolz distorts and misinterprets Mr. Pelley's comments. Taken in context, Mr. Pelley manifestly did not advocate violence against anyone. In fact, his remarks did the opposite. They decried the advocacy of violence. Moreover, editorial comment of this sort is entitled to the highest level of protection under the First Amendment.

For these reasons, the Commission should deny the Second Supplement.
