

Dear Ms. Dortch,

On July 16, 2019, Lawrence Freedman of WorldNet Telecommunications, Inc. ("WorldNet") and Kevin Joseph, special adviser to WorldNet, spoke with Randy Clarke, Acting Legal Advisor to Commissioner Starks. In the discussion, WorldNet reiterated its position that the circumstances in Puerto Rico post-Hurricane, as well as the ongoing economic instability on the island, continue to warrant and justify special consideration by the Commission regarding loops, including among other things, either a carve out, or, in the alternative, an extended sunset period similar or longer than the Commission authorized for transport. WorldNet further explained the special circumstances occurring on the ground in Puerto Rico, as noted in prior filings, that would justify the Commission granting such special consideration for loops.
