Per FCC Rule 1.1206, this letter provides notice that on July 16, 2019, Stephen Spengler, Chief Executive Officer, Intelsat US LLC; Kurt Riegelman, Senior Commercial Advisor, Intelsat US LLC; Steve Corda, Vice President Media Platforms, SES Americom, Inc.; and Jennifer Hindin and Gregg Elias of Wiley Rein LLP, counsel to the C-Band Alliance (“CBA”), met with Nicholas Degani, senior counsel to Chairman Pai, and Aaron Goldberger, advisor to Chairman Pai.

At the meeting, the participants discussed the CBA’s proposal to clear a portion of the C-band for terrestrial 5G use via a market-based mechanism. Mr. Spengler affirmed that the CBA remains committed to clearing a portion of the C-band to meet the nation’s evolving spectrum needs while also ensuring that existing satellite customers can continue to utilize the C-band programming distribution ecosystem that today serves nearly 120 million American households. The meeting participants also discussed timing and next steps in this proceeding.
