Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b), notice is hereby provided of an oral *ex parte* communication in the above-captioned docket. On July 17, 2018, representatives of T-Mobile US, Inc. ("T-Mobile"), Sprint Corporation ("Sprint") and their controlling shareholders¹ met with David Lawrence, Kate Matraves and Charles Mathias, the Director and Deputy Directors of the T-Mobile/Sprint Transaction Team; Tom Johnson and Ashley Boizelle, the General Counsel and Deputy General Counsel; and Don Stockdale and Dana Shaffer, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau Chief and Deputy Bureau Chief. During the meeting, the parties mostly discussed process and timing issues, but did touch on a few substantive matters in response to questions from FCC staff.

In particular, the Applicants reviewed some of the major benefits of the transaction as set forth in the Executive Summary of their Public Interest Statement ("PIS") filed on June 18, 2018. T-Mobile noted that it has a stellar track record in achieving transaction benefits, having met or exceeded projections it made in its applications to acquire MetroPCS. Sprint recapped its standalone future as set out in the Draper Declaration attached to the PIS. In addition, the Applicants emphasized their desire for expeditious review of the transaction.
