On July 14, 2016, the undersigned had a telephone conversation with Stephanie Weiner, Senior Legal Advisor for Chairman Wheeler, regarding the above-referenced E-rate appeal.<sup>1</sup>

In the conversation, I emphasized the detailed, thorough competitive bidding process conducted by the Sweetwater Consortium to select the most cost-effective E-rate services. I respectfully suggested that if the Consortium's competitive bidding process – which met Commission requirements – did not effectuate the Commission's goals underlying those requirements, then the Commission should revise its rules prospectively to ensure the outcome it is seeking in the future.
