After thorough review and investigation of all relevant facts, the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) has made its decision in regard to your appeal of USAC's Funding Year 2014 Notification of Improperly Disbursed Funds Recovery Letter for the Application Number indicated above. This letter explains the basis of USAC's decision. The date of this letter begins the 60 day time period for appealing this decision. Explanation:

- In your appeal you did not provide any new information supporting why the two requested entities should be included for funding On FCC Form 471 #967781. During PLA review neither entity was requested to be added to FCC Form #471#967781. Granite SD invoiced for two entities that were not approved on FCC Form 471 #967781, Transportation-NIF (16083923) and Salt Lake Observation and Assessment-Youth in Custody (17005468). Additionally, these two entities were not listed in the contract for services. Therefore, USAC has denied your appeal.

Since your appeal was denied in full, dismissed or cancelled, you may file an appeal with the FCC. Your appeal must be postmarked within 60 days of the date on this letter. Failure to meet this requirement will result in automatic dismissal of your appeal. You
