Per FCC Rule 1.1206, this letter provides notice that on July 18, 2019, Steve Collar, Chief Executive Officer, SES Americom, Inc.; Stephen Spengler, Chief Executive Officer, Intelsat US LLC; Peter Pitsch, Executive Vice President, Advocacy & Government Relations, C-Band Alliance ("CBA"); and Jennifer Hindin and Gregg Elias of Wiley Rein LLP, counsel to the CBA, met with Chairman Pai; Nicholas Degani, senior counsel to Chairman Pai; and Aaron Goldberger, advisor to Chairman Pai.

At the meeting, the participants discussed the CBA's proposal to clear a portion of the C-band for terrestrial 5G use via a market-based mechanism. Messrs. Collar and Spengler affirmed that the CBA remains committed to clearing portions of the C-band within 18 and 36 months to meet the nation's evolving spectrum needs while also ensuring that existing satellite customers can continue to utilize the C-band programming distribution ecosystem that today serves nearly 120 million American households. The meeting participants also discussed timing and next steps in this proceeding.
