Per FCC Rule 1.1206, this letter provides notice that on July 22, 2019, Peter Pitsch, Executive Vice President, Advocacy & Government Relations, C-Band Alliance ("CBA"); and Jennifer Hindin and Henry Gola of Wiley Rein LLP, counsel to the CBA, had a telephonic meeting with the following FCC personnel: Donald Stockdale, Chief, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau ("WTB"); Giulia McHenry, Acting Chief, Office of Economics and Analytics ("OEA"); Jim Schlichting, Senior Deputy Chief, International Bureau; Dana Shaffer, Deputy Chief, WTB; Matthew Pearl, Assistant Chief, WTB; Patrick DeGraba, Associate Chief, OEA; Evan Kwerel, OEA; and Paul Lafontaine, OEA.

At the meeting, the participants discussed the CBA's proposal to clear a portion of the C-band for terrestrial 5G use via a market-based mechanism. Mr. Pitsch affirmed that it remains committed to clearing portions of the C-band within 18 and 36 months to meet the nation's evolving spectrum needs while also ensuring that existing satellite customers can continue to utilize the C-band programming distribution ecosystem that today serves nearly 120 million American households. The meeting participants also discussed timing and next steps in this proceeding.
