My name is Josh Luthman and I am writing this on behalf of Imagine Networks opposing the proposed changes to the CBRS band.

Imagine Networks is a wireless Internet service provider (WISP) in south west Ohio. Most of our customers are not able to get high speed Internet outside of our service. This includes teachers, doctors, IT staff, families, along with many other positions and situations living in our rural community. A crucial component of our service depends on the very limited resources available to us today.

At the time of this writing we are able to provide service to over 500 customers that simply have not other access to high speed Internet service. Due to the landscape and geography, primarily tree obstructions, it is necessary that we use LTE 3.65 GHz to connect some of these customers. Our most popular plan is 4x1 but we offer a 10x2 plan that some need for busier households.

I have given my entire professional life to building this company and providing service for my community. We are always trying to improve our service and increase our offerings to our fellow community members, but it is imperative that we have the bands available for the manufacturers to invest with us!

We ask that the FCC assist myself and other WISP operators to continually improve and provide for Americans that are not able to get high speed service without the availability of these bands! Imagine Networks strongly OPPOSES the CTIA and Tmobile petitions!
