Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 26, 2017, James Talbot and I, of AT&T, met with Troy Tanner, Denise Coca, David Krech and Veronica Garcia-Ulloa of the International Bureau and Mika Savir of the Office of the Managing Director to discuss issues regarding proposed regulatory fees for International Bearer Circuits ("IBCs") per the above-captioned proceeding. Carol Bourdette of AT&T, Kimberly Cook of the International Bureau, and Thomas Buckley and Roland Helvejian of the Office of the Managing Director participated by conference call.

During the meeting, we expressed AT&T's support for making the regulatory fee assessment more efficient, equitable and less burdensome by applying the existing terrestrial per circuit IBC fees to all terrestrial circuits regardless of regulatory classification. In addition, we discussed the difficulties associated with adoption of a flat per provider fee for terrestrial and satellite circuits. The arguments made were consistent with AT&T's prior filings in the above-referenced proceeding.
