On July 26, 2017, Chuck Powers of Motorola Solutions, Inc. (“MSI”) and myself met with Scot Stone, Tom Derenge and Charles Eberle of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau to discuss issues raised in the Commission proceeding to review the rules governing the Personal Radio Services (“PRS”) authorized under Part 95 of its rules.<sup>1</sup> Our discussions focused solely on the Commission’s actions in the Report and Order concerning the transmission of GPS location information and user-generated text messages over GMRS frequencies<sup>2</sup> in order to fully understand the Commission’s concerns over automatically generated data transmissions.
