IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING YOUR LOCAL TELEPHONE SERVICE

Dear Valued Rothsay Telephone Company Customer:

We are writing to let you know that the Park Region Mutual Telephone Company (Park Region), through a subsidiary, will be purchasing the telecommunications business of Rothsay Telephone Company (Rothsay) on approximately August 31, 2016. Once that transaction is complete, your local telephone service will be provided by Park Region's subsidiary Rothsay Acquisition, Inc. (RAI), which will operate under the name "Rothsay Telephone Company."

This transition will involve no charge to you and will occur within the next forty five (45) days. After the transition, the local telephone service that you currently receive from Rothsay will be provided by RAI under the name "Rothsay Telephone Company." Your first bill after the transfer will notify you that the transfer occurred as of a specified date. You will not be charged any fees or costs for this transfer; RAI will be responsible for any change charges associated with the transfer.

The terms and conditions of the service you receive will not change as a result of the transfer to RAI. Your rates for service will not increase as a result of the transfer. The rates, terms and conditions for your local service are included on a separate sheet with this notice. By using these services, you are agreeing to these terms and conditions, as they may be modified from time to time as posted on RAI's web site at www.prtel.com, and on file with the Minnesota Department of Commerce.

You are free to choose another local service provider at any time; and you can do so by contacting your choice of carrier(s) that offer local telephone service in your area. In the event you chose a carrier other than RAI within the next thirty (30) days, you will not incur a carrier change charge. If such a charge appears on one of your bills after the transfer of your services to RAI, you do not need to contact us as a credit for the charge will be placed on your account and appear on your bill within 60 days.

All customers receiving this notice, even those who have arranged preferred local service carrier freezes through Rothsay, will be transferred unless you select a different carrier before the transfer to RAI has occurred. In addition, any existing preferred local service carrier freezes you may have on local telephone service will be lifted. If you would like a freeze to be reinstated after your transfer to RAI for local telephone service, you must request a new freeze at that time. You may do this by calling the toll free number listed below for RAI, after the transfer has occurred.

RAI will be responding to any complaints filed, or otherwise raised, during the transition period prior to and during the transfer of customers to RAI. RAI can be reached toll free at 1-800-247-2706. If you have questions for Rothsay, you may contact Rothsay toll free at 1-888-230-2111.
