Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of the Assignees Westside Independent Telephone Company, d/b/a Western Iowa Networks ("Westside") and BTC, Inc., d/b/a Western Iowa Networks ("BTC"), the following additional information is provided with respect to the referenced pending "Application for Streamlined Assignment of Domestic Blanket Section 214 Authorizations" with respect to the assets of Arcadia Telephone Cooperative ("Arcadia") and Monarc Technologies, LLC ("Monarc"):

1. A List of the Board of Directors for Breda Telephone Company, d/b/a Western Iowa Networks, the parent company of all of the Western Iowa Networks companies.
2. An Organizational Chart for the Western Iowa Networks companies prior to the proposed transaction.
3. An Organizational Chart for the Western Iowa Networks companies after the proposed transaction.
4. A map showing how the Arcadia, Iowa exchange of Arcadia Telephone Cooperative and the Dennison, Iowa service area of Monarc Technologies are situated with respect to existing Western Iowa Networks service areas.

Westside and BTC confirm that the Arcadia exchange is adjacent to existing Western Iowa Networks exchange areas, but that there are no areas where Western Iowa Network exchanges and Arcadia's Arcadia exchange overlap one another. Tele-Services, Ltd., a Western Iowa Networks affiliate, provides cable television service within the Arcadia local exchange service area, but Arcadia itself does not provide cable television service there.

Both Western Iowa Networks and Arcadia/Monarc resell non-facilities-based nationwide long distance toll services, and it is possible that they could be deemed to “compete” for customers in and around their service areas. However, they do not compete with respect to the facilities-based local exchange voice services, switched and special access services, cable television services and Internet access services that they offer.
